


- Number of English-medium specialized courses in the undergraduate programs increased by approximately 30% to 165 courses since 2018
- The numerical target of global active learning enrollees has already been achieved. New programs such as hybrid international internships are under development



What is Global Active Learning Courses?

- Courses in which debate and group work in a foreign language are central to the class and designed to encourage students to actively engage in learning
- ✓ Representative examples are the dual Seminar System, in which students take a specialized seminar class in English in addition to their Japanese-medium seminar, and an online active learning course offered in collaboration with SIGMA, an alliance of nine social science universities worldwide
