
Percentage of working adults among students

(graduate students)



Hitotsubashi Senior Executive Program (HSEP)

Training program for top management in Japanese companies. Implemented since AY 2002, more than 500 participants have taken the course thus far

To develop the next generation of CFOs; four types of program (A-D) by tier; implemented since FY2015, more than 1,100 participants have taken the course thus far
