

(To all students) Notice about 2020 Spring-Summer Semester lectures

26 March, 2020

The start of some lectures for the Spring-Summer Semester of the 2020 academic year will be postponed until Monday 20 April, and these lectures will take place via video streaming. All other lectures will start from Monday 6 April, as scheduled.

1. For lectures taking place in classrooms, careful attention will be paid to ventilation (avoiding closed spaces).
2. Students and lecturers inside the classrooms will be kept at a distance of at least one meter apart from each other (avoiding crowds and close contact).
3. For lectures with a large number of students, where the measures listed in 1. and 2. above are difficult to implement, video streaming will be used, and streaming will begin from Monday 20 April.

The university's policy, from the standpoint of maintaining educational quality as well as the health of students and staff, is to ensure opportunities for classroom lectures as far as possible, making the most of the particular conditions of our location and facilities, such as our spacious suburban campus and our low-rise lecture buildings.
