

Hitotsubashi University Graduate School of Business Administration Tenure-Track Faculty Position in Marketing

Position: Graduate School of Business Administration at Hitotsubashi University (Tokyo, Japan) seeks a full-time tenure-track Assistant Professor or Associate Professor. Applications in all areas of marketing will be considered. Successful candidates will start teaching in April 2019 and mainly teach undergraduates in the Global Leadership Program, MBA students(Global Marketing), and Ph.D. students. They also have time and resources to conduct their own research and will be expected to participate in Hitotsubashi University's active research community, by interacting with Ph.D. students and research faculty.

Qualifications: Ph.D. in Marketing or equivalent. Successful candidates will combine an emphasis on research with enthusiasm for teaching some of the best undergraduate students in Japan, and for contributing to the vibrant research community at Hitotsubashi University. Teaching and research-related activities will be conducted in English.
