1. Position and number of openings: One assistant professor (tenure track)
2. Department: International Business Strategy course, Management and Finance major, Graduate School of International Corporate Strategy
3. Responsibilities: Operations management
4. Qualifications: Candidates must meet all of the following criteria
 - Understands the principles of the International Business Strategy course, and can take part and engage in education and research activities
 - Demonstrates a broad range of knowledge and experience in international matters
 - Proficient in English for providing guidance in classes and with academic dissertations
 - Holder of Ph.D. or doctoral degree

6. Duration: Five years from start date (a screening will be performed before the expiration of the five-year tenure track period; if successful, the appointee will be promoted to a tenured position)

5. List of projects, research or other, for which you received or took part in receiving external funding (up to past five years)
6. List of academic society memberships and humanitarian activities
7. Your motivation for engaging in education and research activities at Hitotsubashi University (free format, up to two A4 sheets, in Japanese and English)
8. Your policy for providing guidance to graduate students at Hitotsubashi University (free format, up to two A4 sheets, in Japanese and English)
9. One letter of recommendation from a person who can appraise your academic and research history
