

What is the International House?

- (1) It is the dormitory for the international students of Hitotsubashi University and foreign researchers. It offers good opportunities for mutual exchange among residents. Four Japanese students also live in there to support international students.
- (2) There are two buildings, A for single persons and B for married couples and families.
(Single person cannot apply for or live in the couple or family rooms.)

Location: 2-1 Naka, Kunitachi-shi, Tokyo 186-0004 (at the Kunitachi campus)

Dormitory Fees, Management Charges, and Deposit:

Residents pay dormitory fee and Asunaro Kai membership fee by a given day every month. The amounts payable are shown in the following table. Residents shall also pay a deposit at the time of moving-in. The deposit will be reimbursed at the time of leaving the House if any amount remains after deducting cleaning expenses, expenditure for fixing damages and other costs. When there is any deficiency, such amount will be collected.

**Residents have to pay other utility services like electricity, in which used at private contract, directly to the relevant companies.

** Asunaro Kai is the resident's association of International House.

* There is no trunk room for residents at the International House so that you cannot bring in large/many stuff, especially to single rooms.

Telephone/Internet

- (1) The internal line can be used. For utilizing outside/international telephone lines, you should purchase pre-paid cards.
- (2) There is the computer room in the House, however you cannot use the Internet there except one month after move in. If you would like to use the Internet at your own room, you have to make a contract with a provider.
